America Declares Independence from Globalism

The 2025 National Security Strategy: Our New Declaration of Independence

It is now official. The Trump administration has declared America's full independence from globalist control in the new 33-page strategic policy document, "National Security Strategy of the United States of America."

This is a revolution that can be compared to our Declaration of Independence in 1776, which freed the nation from British rule and the Emancipation Proclamation ending slavery in 1863. Now in 2025, this National Security Strategy document declares our nation's freedom from globalist policy subordination.

With this document there can no longer be any ambiguity or second guessing about what America stands for, its purpose, and its mission. No longer is the U.S. military the enforcer of the globalist world order. No longer is the U.S. going to tolerate in our hemisphere narco states and the drug trade of the globalist financial empire and their cartels which comprise the actual foreign power invading and occupying our nation.

This National Security Strategy is not just a policy document—it is a declaration that America will no longer be subordinate to globalist institutions that seek to dissolve our sovereignty. It defines clearly what we stand for: nation-state sovereignty, economic security for American workers, energy independence, secure borders, and peace through strength rather than endless wars.

The 2026 elections will determine whether Congress supports this vision of American sovereignty or returns us to globalist subordination. Every American must understand what is at stake.

What follows are selected excerpts:

How Strategy Went Astray: After the end of the Cold War, American foreign policy elites convinced themselves that permanent American domination of the entire world was in the best interests of our country. Yet the affairs of other countries are our concern only if their activities directly threaten our interests.

Our elites badly miscalculated America's willingness to shoulder forever global burdens to which the American people saw no connection to the national interest. They overestimated America's ability to fund, simultaneously, a massive welfare regulatory administrative state alongside a massive military, diplomatic, intelligence, and foreign aid complex. They placed hugely misguided and destructive bets on globalism and so-called 'free trade' that hollowed out the very middle class and industrial base on which American economic and military preeminence depend.

What America Wants: Restoring Our Nation: The restoration and reinvigoration of American spiritual and cultural health...We want a people who are proud, happy, and optimistic that they will leave their country to the next generation better than they found it. We want a gainfully employed citizenry—with no one sitting on the sidelines—who take satisfaction from knowing that their work is essential to the prosperity of our nation and to the well-being of individuals and families. This cannot be accomplished without growing numbers of strong, traditional families that raise healthy children.

The Primacy of Nations Over Globalist Institutions: The world's fundamental political unit is and will remain the nation-state...We stand for the sovereign rights of nations, against sovereignty-sapping incursions of the most intrusive

transnational organizations, and for reforming those institutions so that they assist rather than hinder individual sovereignty and further American interests.

The President of Peace: President Trump has leveraged his dealmaking ability to secure unprecedented peace in eight conflicts throughout the world over the course of just eight months of his second term...Stopping regional conflicts before they spiral into global wars that drag down whole continents is worthy of the Commander-in-Chief's attention, and a priority for this administration.

Flexible Realism: Respecting National Sovereignty: Flexible Realism – We seek good relations and peaceful commercial relations with the nations of the world without imposing on them democratic or other social change that differs widely from their traditions and histories.

Relations with Russia: It is a core interest of the United States to negotiate an expeditious cessation of hostilities in Ukraine...and reestablish strategic stability with Russia, as well as to enable the post-hostilities reconstruction of Ukraine to enable its survival as a viable state.

Economic Security Is National Security: The United States must maintain the strongest economy, develop the most advanced technologies, bolster our society's cultural health, and field the world's most capable military.

- *Economic Security: Putting American Workers First: Pro-American Worker* – American policy will be pro-worker, not merely pro-growth, and it will prioritize our own workers. We must rebuild an economy in which prosperity is broadly based and widely shared, not concentrated at the top or localized in certain industries or a few parts of our country.
- *Balanced Trade* – The United States will prioritize rebalancing our trade relations, reducing trade deficits, opposing barriers to our exports, and ending dumping and other anti-competitive practices that hurt American industries and workers.
- *Reindustrialization* – The United States will reindustrialize its economy, 're-shore'

industrial production, and encourage and attract investment in our economy and our workforce, with a focus on the critical and emerging technology sectors that will define the future.

- *Energy Dominance:* Rejecting the Climate Ideology: Energy Dominance – Restoring American energy dominance (in oil, gas, coal, and nuclear) and reshoring the necessary key energy components is a top strategic priority...We reject the disastrous 'climate change' and 'Net Zero' ideologies that have so greatly harmed Europe, threaten the United States, and subsidize our adversaries.

The Trump Corollary to the Monroe Doctrine: After years of neglect, the United States will reassert and enforce the Monroe Doctrine to restore American preeminence in the Western Hemisphere, and to protect our homeland and our access to key geographies throughout the region. We will deny non-Hemispheric competitors the ability to position forces or other threatening capabilities, or to own or control strategically vital assets, in our Hemisphere.

The Era of Mass Migration Is Over: Border security is the primary element of national security. We must protect our country from invasion, not just from unchecked migration but from cross-border threats such as terrorism, drugs, espionage, and human trafficking. A border controlled by the will of the American people as implemented by their government is fundamental to the survival of the United States as a sovereign republic
